

Retake Policy

Students who do not pass the IB Diploma in their original examination session are allowed to retake any failed subjects. The following policy clarifies the retake procedure.

Students who pass their subjects or the IB Diploma but are not satisfied with the scores that they obtained may request an Enquiry Upon Results (EUR), also known as a remark. Details of this process can be found in the EUR Policy.

Retakes are only available to students who were previously enrolled at Aarhus Gymnasium, Tilst.

The school only offers DP examinations in May only. Students wishing to retake an exam must therefore wait until the May session the following year.

All candidates, including retake students, must be registered for their examinations in autumn of the preceding year. Consequently, any student intending to retake one or more examinations must inform the IB Coordinator at the school in writing of their intention to retake one or more subjects no later than October 1st.

The IB Coordinator will determine whether it is realistic for the student to achieve a passing grade in the subject or to obtain the Diploma through a retake session. Permissions to retake will not be granted if a successful outcome is deemed unlikely.

Retakes will be at the cost of the student. The fee is for each subject for which a student is registered is 100 EUR. The fee will be paid via Safeticket and billing information will be sent out once the exam registration deadline has passed in November.

Students are responsible for preparing independently for any retake examinations and for ensuring they are aware of any curriculum changes since their previous examination session. Retake students should not expect to borrow teaching material, to receive instructional time, or additional support from their former subject teachers.

The dates of the IB exams are published well in advance, and it is the student's responsibility to avoid any scheduling conflicts during the examination period. Prior to the exam session, the school will contact all retake students to confirm their exam meeting times and to provide information regarding any updates or changes to examination procedures.
